We are pleased to announce that Senator Jon Tester (D-Montana), Chairman of the Senate Veterans' Affairs Committee, has teamed up with U.S. Senator Marco Rubio (R-Fla.) to introduce bipartisan legislation (<http://veterans.senate.gov/services/files/72EA1A73-OB4C-479F-BOBC-99F3539E8105>) to expand comprehensive research of birth defects among Descendants of toxic-exposed veterans.

Now is the time, each one of us must contact our Senate members to show our excitement in this endeavor. While there has been some research on the link between birth defects and generational exposure to toxins and chemical, there has yet to be comprehensive, government led studies into effects of toxic exposure on descendants of toxic-exposed veterans. The Molly R. Loomis Research for Descendants of Toxic Exposed Veterans Act would commission first-of-its-kind, landmark research of birth defects among descendants of toxic exposed veterans, enabled by the PACT ACT.
